In 2016 Cambodia's garment workers won their campaign for minimum wages.

Now discussions are underway between the government, employers and unions for minimum wages for all other workers.

But unions remain deeply concerned because the government laws proscribe fines for unions involved in the process but who are critical of it.

Sar Mora, President of Cambodian Food and Service Workers Federation (CFSWF) says close to no research exists on a living wage for workers outside of the garment industry.

Sok Kin, Vice President of Building And Wood Workers Trade Union Of Cambodia

(BWTUC), says that local unions will work to amend the draft laws but need support and pressure from the ILO and global workers groups to win their campaign.
